The Learning Specialist position includes the following tasks, among others:

Create and update learning support and behavior plans based on evaluation reports.

Attend Student Support Team and Grade Level Meetings.

Coordinate AIMSweb assessments and MAP assessments.

Meet with parents to discuss learning plans and concerns when needed.

Consult with teachers regarding the scaffolding and modifying curriculum.

Work with teachers to review assessment results and plan interventions as needed.

Act as a case manager for students with learning plans and facilitate meetings between teachers and parents as well as external providers when applicable.

Successful candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree, a strong commitment to a PK-12 education and learning support, strong interpersonal, organizational and managerial skills, high energy, flexibility, warmth, sense of humor, and a collaborative team player.
